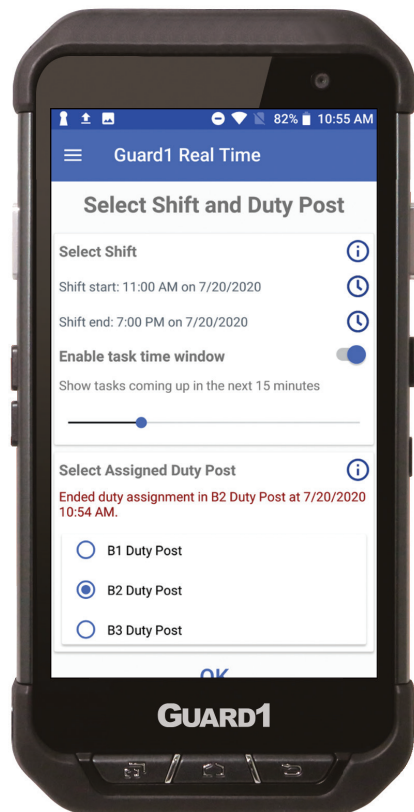
Our tracking tags give you a 360° view of facility, letting you track inmate movement in real-time and know exactly where they are.

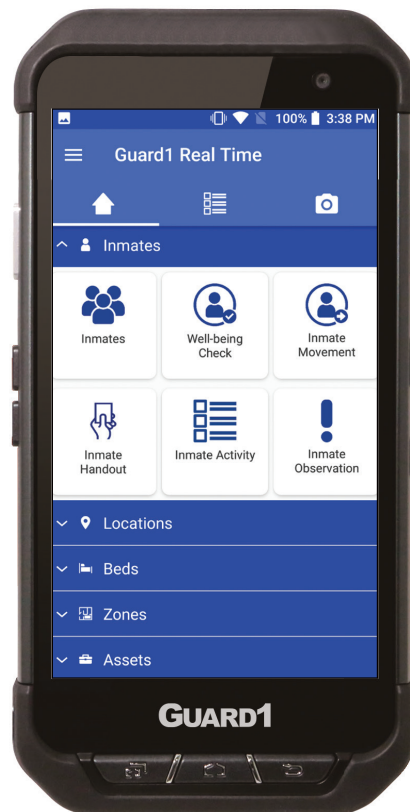
The whiteboard view shows who is currently in every zone – with virtual headcounts and in/out counts

## Keep staff and visitors safe.

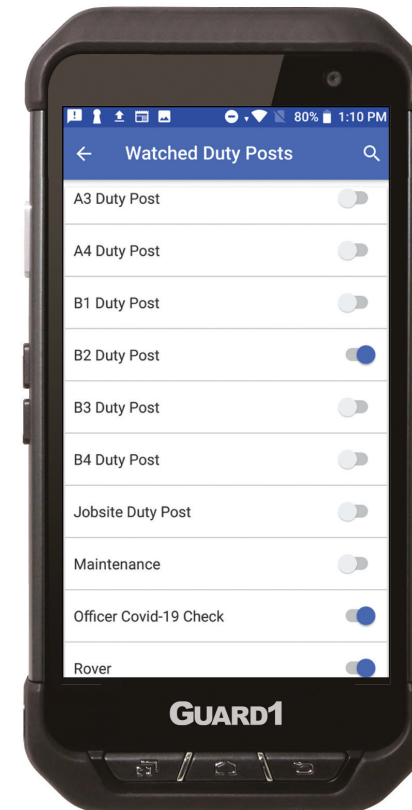
