

# Gregg County Sheriff's Office Moves to Nearly 100% Paperless Log

## The Challenge

### Manual Jail Logs

Gregg County Sheriff's Office was looking for a system that would validate their time accuracy in real-time. They were also looking for a system that would maintain electronic records for their 3 divisions.

## The Outcome

### Nearly 100% Paperless Logs

With GUARD1, Gregg County Sheriff's Office has been able to eliminate paper logs. Now they're at about 98% paperless for their logs in their facility, with extensive digital logs for state inspections and real-time monitoring for their multiple facilities.

"Gregg County has 3 divisions - Minimum/medium security, medium/maximum security, and a minimum security facility. Currently we're about 98% paperless other than recreation logs - and the only reason we're not 100% paperless is because we haven't come up with a good way of doing that yet."

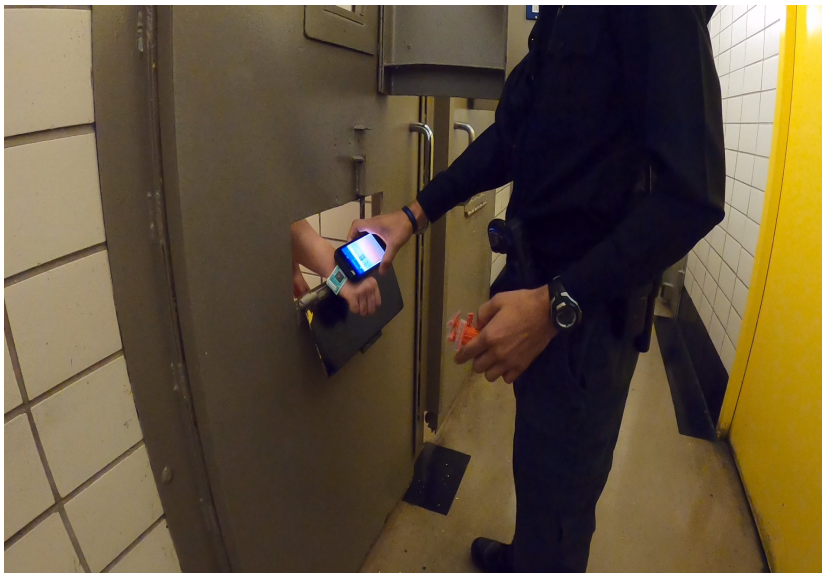
