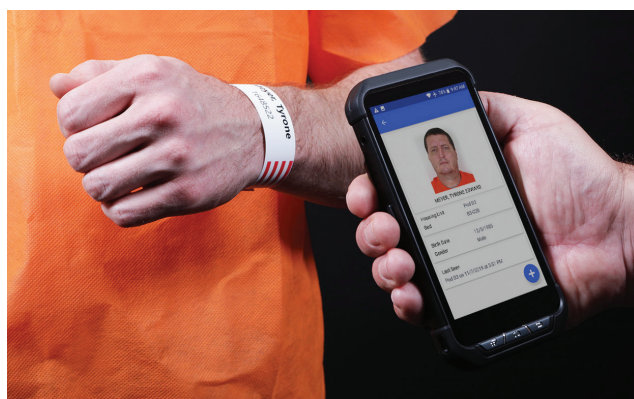

- Optional NFC/RFID tag attaches discreetly in the clasp

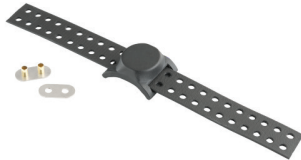

Inmate Movement and Location Tracking

- Know the location of every inmate in your facility, in real time

Duress Signaling for Officers & Visitors

- Emergency signaling with the Duress Device
- Secondary alerts for man down, no movement, removed from holster
- Know the location of any alert

Alerts

- Missed well-being checks
- Inmate keep-separates and out-of-bounds
- Officer or visitor Duress Device emergencies

Facility Maps

- View alerts on a map of your facility
- See who is in any zone

Duty Logs

- Officer see tasks specific to their duty post
- Officers have an electronic list of who receives Special or Regular Meals, Razor or No Razor Permitted, Medication, etc.
- Officers document activities and handouts by scanning an inmate RFID wristband or selecting the individual from the list

Inmate Detail

- A complete history of inmate activities, well-being checks, and movement history

Whiteboard View

- Housing assignments
- Inmate location
- Head counts and in/out counts
