Manual Safety Checks Without Real-Time Verification

With an average daily population of 1,300 inmates and a capacity of 1,451, ensuring timely and thorough safety checks was crucial but challenging with traditional methods. They needed a solution that would allow real-time monitoring and eliminate patterns in safety checks that could compromise security.

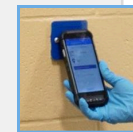
